*Fold and pleat paper into drunken irregular starburst.*

*Place vase in center and smush paper over and around it.*

*Push daisy stems in and out of holes, like giant hatpins.*



# Wednesdaisy,

I was just about to trash this junkmail, and then — *whoa, those cheesy ads are kind of cute. They'd be perfect with daisies and ditch-lilies.....*

*So: Fold and pleat and bunch paper into completely nonsensical every-which-way freeform pop-up.*

# Thursday

I go paperless.

Idea is to see how high you can stack daisies up and up without the entire thing tipping over.

*Key: If you can intertwine all the wiry stems into a curlicue tower, then everything supports everything else (with a bit of help from real wire).*
